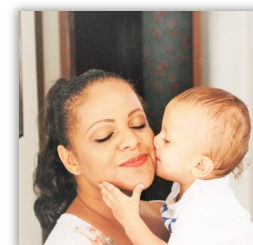
## **Parents Working Together**
