- Any portion of a statement exceeding 3 minutes will not be read aloud; but, will be included in the official record.

How to Comment on Agenda Items Requiring Noticed Public Hearing

Individuals present at the meeting who wish to speak during the Public Hearing on Agenda Item 8.6 must submit a “Request to Address the Board” form by the time the Board opens the public hearing and must limit their comments to no more than 3 minutes.

All comments regarding the Public Hearing submitted by mail, email, and voice message must be received by 9 a.m. on July 13, 2020, and be limited to 300 words, not to exceed 3 minutes in length. These public comments will be read aloud by a staff member during public hearing. Any portion of a public comment submitted by mail, email, or voice message extending beyond the three (3) minute limitation will not be read aloud; but, will be included in the official record.

Comments received after the close of the Public Hearing will be treated like a general public comment and made part of the record of proceeding, provided that such comment is received prior to the end of the meeting.
